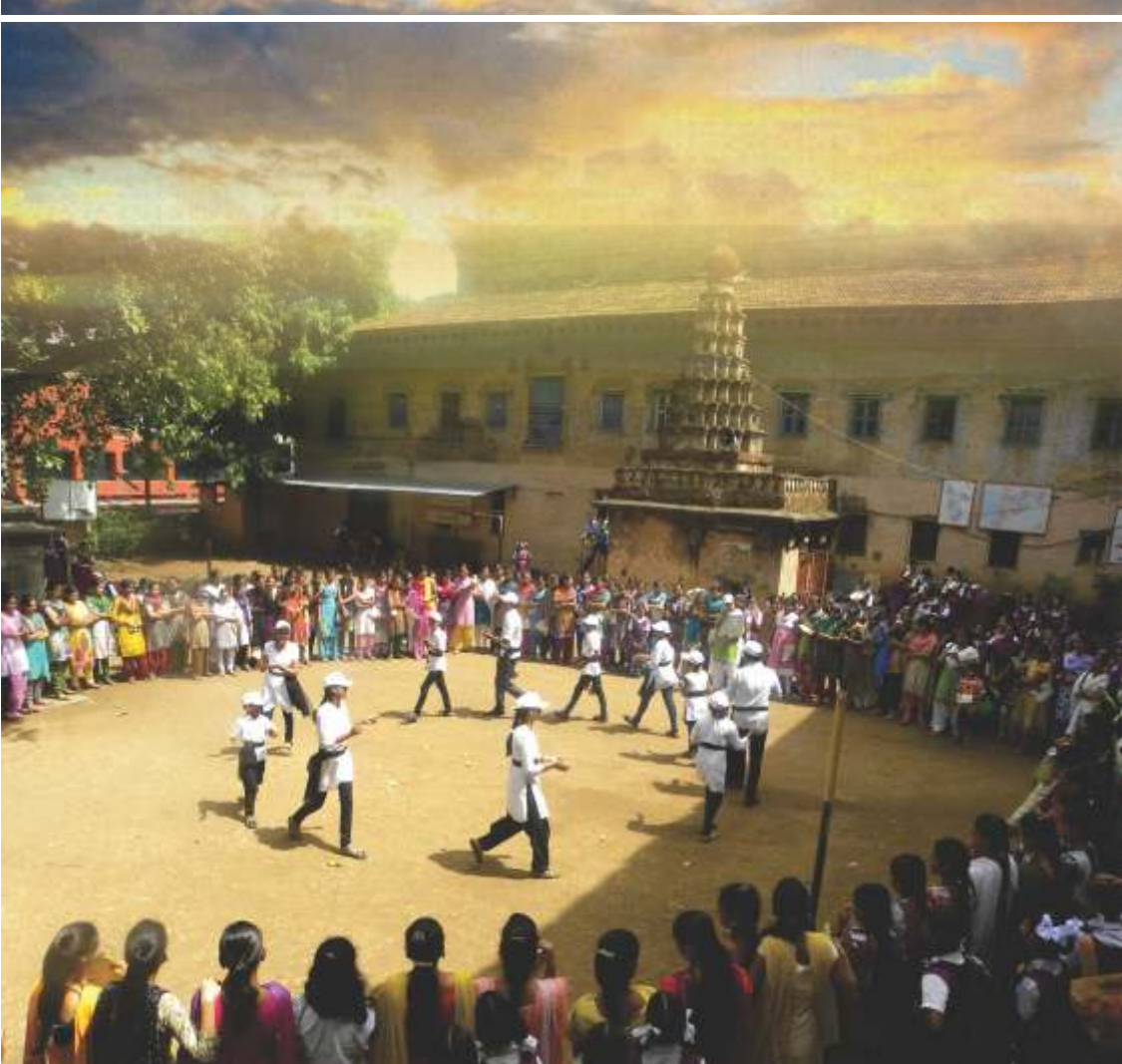

2. AASTHA Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR) for the Persons with Disabilities (PWDs)

Advocacy has a prominent role to play when we work as a mediator between Government and people. Samardhan helps the children, men and women to make them aware of different government schemes and enable them to benefit from them. It has linked hundreds of women, men and children with various schemes.

9. HARITA Protection of environment

Environmental protection through promoting alternate energy, organic farming, agro based innovations, protection, procreation and promotion of local breeds both in animals as well as plants.
